

HEY PARENTS! I need your help. We have several job vacancies to fill so that Youth Ministry will run smoothly this year. Below are the job openings and brief descriptions about their rolls. Please consider volunteering your time to help our programs! **Just a reminder....there will be a Parent Meeting next Sunday at the end of our Youth Ministry time. The meeting will take place in the Church from 8-8:30 p.m.**

Job Vacancies:

Jr. Sr High Catechist: This position works with Juniors and Seniors in High school by developing lesson plans from Center for Ministry Development Access for the weeks when there is Confirmation Program.

Confirmation II: We need a room parent to be a second adult in the room when we have Confirmation breakout sessions. This person will help with administrative tasks such as taking attendance, passing out or making copies for presenters, hosting presenters, making sure room is in order after meeting, helping youth make sure they are staying on track by completing criteria, and making some phone calls for reminder messages.

Confirmation I: We need at least one parent to serve as Catechist with another rookie Catechist. Catechists are provided with a teaching manual and all resources to make that first year of Confirmation a solid foundation for their experience. Confirmation meets 12 times a year.

7/8<sup>th</sup> grade Catechist: We need one additional Catechist to co teach with a veteran Catechist. Teachings are taken from the Center for Ministry Development Access website and applied to their faith. As well as some additional material that can come from a variety of resources.

Confirmation Retreat Teams: We will need 4-5 Adults per Confirmation Class to serve on a Confirmation Retreat Team to help plan the retreats for our Confirmation youth. Confirmation I Retreat is to be held on January 10<sup>th</sup> and Confirmation II Retreat to be held on March 27/28<sup>th</sup>.

Planning Team: We need to develop a group of parents and Parishioners to serve on a Youth Ministry Planning Team. Youth Ministry has never had this is place so we would be working on developing a Mission and what roles are the first year and develop the planning team to be a supportive body for Youth Ministry for future planning.

Can you help our Youth Ministry program in some way? We have a large number of youth that come to our programs on a weekly basis. It takes a village to raise a child. Would you consider stepping forward and helping out? After 7 years in Youth Ministry I can say without a doubt; you will get more out of volunteering than you give. It is a great opportunity to build the faith of our young community and at the same time building our own as well. Don't see a job on here that you can do but would like to help out in another way...let Chris know what your idea is and we will see what we can do!
