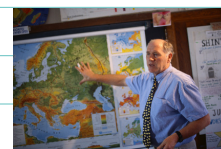


## CONGRATULATIONS!!!

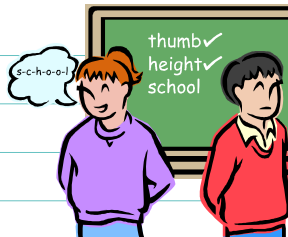
## Congratulations (continued)

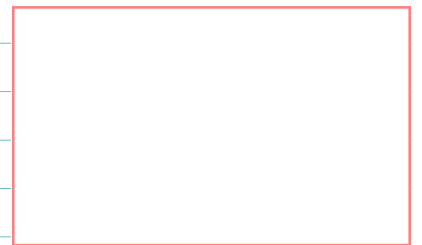
